MUSIC

Electric Bass: *Taught by Gary (Juju) Garlic.* Students must provide their own instrument. Fundamental approach to bass applied to several styles of music, including Contemporary, Christian, Blues, Straight, and Swing. Learn to create the perfect baseline!

Reading Music and Rhythm: *Taught by Gary (Juju) Garlic.* This is music reading made simple, for all ages! Bring a notebook and have fun learning music fundamentals that will last a lifetime.

Digital Music Production: *Taught by Gary (Juju) Garlic.* Want to create music in a form that can be shared all over the world? DMP will get you started. Students will learn today's techniques of recording, tracking, sampling, and mixing music using a DAW digital workstation.

Beginning Piano: *Taught by Gary G. Garlic Jr.* Students will learn proper piano technique and chord voicings that will lead to understanding application to scales and songs in many styles of music.

Beginning Percussion: *Taught by Gary G. Garlic Jr.* Study technique, an application of several percussion instruments, played together in a group setting while having a fun, learning experience!

Beginning Drums: *Taught by Gary G. Garlic Jr.* Introduction to a musical approach to drumming, from technique to dynamics. Your band will appreciate it!

DRAMA

Introduction to Acting: *Taught by Bekah Conley.* Get stage ready as you learn the basics of vocal technique and body movement in a fun and dynamic class setting.

Improvisational Acting: *Taught by Bekah Conley.* Acting with no script. Implement the rules of improvisational acting by playing stage games and creating zany, original scenes.

The Joy of Puppets: *Taught by Bekah Conley.* Take a deep dive into the world of puppets. We will play, learn, and perform as you create your very own puppet characters.

DANCE

Jazz Dance: Taught by Angela Myers. Students will explore an energetic dance style and learn basic jazz technique as a form of worship. They will have the opportunity to dance to upbeat music and be creative through dance.

Hip Hop Dance: *Taught by Angela Myers.* Come get your spirit swag on! Students will be introduced to basic hip hop dance styles. With the

use of Isolations and Rhythms, students will find their unique styles in dance.

Lyrical Dance: *Taught by Angela Myers.* Through personal expression and creativity, students will learn to connect their movement with the music and lyrics. This class will include foundation of ballet and a mix of jazz dance, all used for worship.

ART

Impressions of Hummel on Cardstock: Taught by Mary Sawyer. Students will choose a favorite Hummel, then begin sketching forms using pencil contour lines in dividing positive and negative space. Next, we will block in color using pastel/watercolor pencil/charcoal & ink on cardstock. Finished work will be placed in a 5" x 7" glass frame suitable for gift giving.

Sunset Silhouette Pastel Paintings Taught by Mary Sawyer. Using Black Paint/French Pastel/Charcoal. Students will discover the origin/history of 'Silhouettes'. We will creatively paint a pastel background upon which our Sunset Silhouette Form will be placed. Students will learn Art Terms: Background/Foreground, positive & negative Space, Art Principle EMPHASIS, Art Elements COLOR, LINE, FORM in creating a pleasing silhouette form using black paint upon a colorful & expressive pastel painting background. Each finished piece will include appropriate Scriptural calligraphy and will be mounted in an 8" x 10" glass frame suitable for aift giving.

3D Bas Relief Plaster/Clay Sculptural Frescoes: Student's Choice: *Taught by Mary Sawyer.* This all-time student favorite features traditional 3D Plaster Bas Relief Sculptures where students will learn how to effectively use the Art Elements positive & negative Space, Form, Color, Texture and Art Principle Emphasis as they prepare a plaster surface, carve using clay/sculpture tools on plaster & clay, then turn reliefs into "FRESCOES" by painting. Students will be encouraged to design a creative sculptural form expressing their unique ideas and interests – possibly a 3D depiction of our theme.

Animal Portraits - Inspired by Janet Hyun: Taught by Sarah Sawyer. Inspired by Janet Hyun using Acrylics on an 12"x12" canvas textured cardstock. The color wheel will be used to create a delectable treat for viewers to enjoy when viewing all the varied styles of brushstrokes. Students will study artwork of famous Christian artist Janet Hyun and begin sketching, color blocking, background/ foreground development using varieties of techniques and additional media. We will explore the different types of brushes Janet uses for her work, and how to properly use the tools to create the desired piece. Finished pieces will be suitable for framing.

Biblical Impasto Master Study - Inspired by Ron DiCianni:

Taught by Sarah Sawyer. In this project, students will be analyzing the artwork of Ron DiCianni, and use Impasto and Acrylics on 8"x10" canvas panel for their own interpretation. Students will be introduced to Christian artist, Ron DiCianni, who is known for his popular piece "Spiritual Warfare", however; in 2010, he completed a 12-foot x 40 ft piece called "The Resurrection Mural" (The Resurrection Mural is considered to be the largest contemporary painting depicting Christ's resurrection in the world.) We will begin sketching preliminaries, color coordinating, and developing art using a variety of techniques by Ron DiCianni. Finished pieces will be suitable for gift-giving.

Floral/Foliage Motif - Inspired by Margaret Neilson

Armstrong: *Taught by Sarah Sawyer.* Inspired by Margaret Neilson Armstrong's incredible Floral Paintings using Acrylics on a wooden plaque. She is known as being the first woman in the states to produce a comprehensive guide of the wildflowers in the American west called "Field Book of Western Wild Flowers" (1915). This project encourages students to create a unique design for their favorite flower/foliage while implementing artistic techniques from Margaret Armstrong. Students will be incorporating the name of the plant as well as their own signature in the style of Art Nouveau in the piece. We will introduce keen observational skills, color blocking, how to use a color wheel, and provide the experience of a classic artist. Finished pieces will be suitable for framing.

COOKING

Creation in the Kitchen: *Taught by Amy Newberry.* Students will learn all about God Given food; learning how to prep, cook, and finally enjoy their tasty creations each day. Each day's lesson has coordinating recipes and age-appropriate tasks to help kids develop a passion and interest in a variety of fun, kid-friendly healthy foods.

Day 1 will focus on creation and how God created all thing for our good and His glory. God was so intentional to give us resource we need even during each season! Colossians 1:16

Day 2 & 3 Creation of Human/Our Sin and His Forgiveness. We will talk about how God given food combined in the right ways can help heal our bodies like the salvation gift of Jesus heals our spirit. Revelation 4:11 and John 14:6

Day 4 Created to Serve. The message is that God gave us resources to serve others and fellowship with them. This is possible when we honor Him by taking care of His creation. Galatian 5:13 and Philippians 4:18
